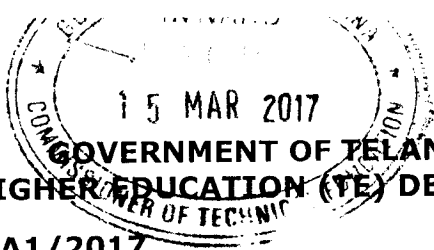

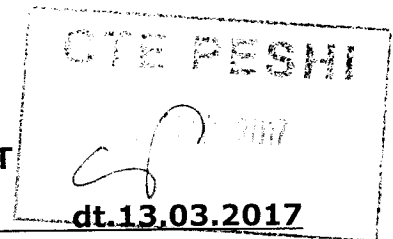

The Ministry of Human Resource Development releases funds to State Governments for implementation of Schemes under the "Sub-Mission on Polytechnics" including the Scheme of "Community Development through Polytechnics".

I have observed that there is some delay in transferring the funds received from MHRD to the Institutes implementing the Scheme, which is hampering the proper implementation of the Scheme. I would be grateful if you could instruct all concerned to ensure that such grants are transferred to the Institutes concerned without any delay.

Under Community Development through Polytechnics, you may be aware that the rural population including SC/STs, women, school dropouts are imparted skill training by courses of 3 to 6 months duration. I would request you to give instructions to the Polytechnics implementing this scheme to impart training on digital financial transactions also to the trainees so that the trainees and their family members could be encouraged to use the same. The penetration of mobile phones in rural areas is quite good and hence such training would help them in learning about digital financial transactions which would go a long way in ensuring less-cash transactions in the country.
